

Higest temprartures recorded at Rajshahi

Rajshahi has met its highest temperature at 39.9 degrees Celsius on 28 April and experiencing moderate heat wave. Among the other divisions, the highest temperature in Dhaka was 36, Mymensingh 30.7, Chittagong 34, Sylhet 31.8, Rangpur 29.9, Khulna 37.2 and Barisal 34.4 degrees Celsius.

It is to be mentioned that on June 12, 2005, Rajshahi recorded the highest temperature of 42.8 degree Celsius. Then on May 21, 2014, 42.6 degree Celsius and 41.2 degree Celsius was reached on 29 April 2016. Then this maximum temperature has not exceeded in the divisional city of Rajshahi. Besides, the highest temperature recorded in Rajshahi on May 18, 1972 was 45.1 degrees Celsius.

The number of patients increased in Rajshahi Medical College Hospital due to the intense heat. Patients especially elder persons and children are suffering from diarrhea, fever, flux and cough in the hospital all over the country. Cyclone Fani/Foni lies over the southeast bay
