

Cyclone Fani turned into a weak Tropical storm but

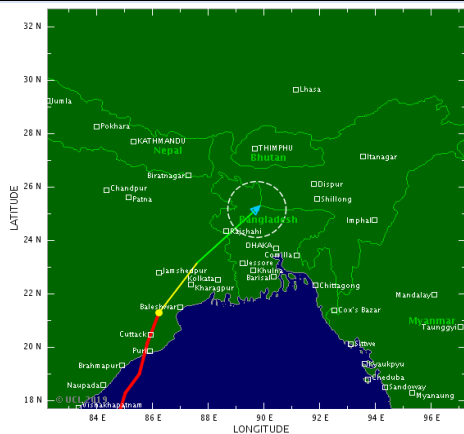

The severe cyclonic storm “FANI” (pronunciation: FONI) over Gangetic West Bengal and adjoining southwestern part of Bangladesh moved north-northeastwards further, weakened into a cyclonic storm and located over Satkhira, Jashore & Khulna region and adjoining area at 06 am in the morning of 4th May, 2019. The **danger signal** no. SEVEN, danger signal no. SIX and signal no. FOUR for are also remaining the same for Mongla & Payra port, Chattogram ports and

Cox’s Bazar ports respectively.

Eight people have been killed as cyclone Fani made a landfall in Puri on Orrisa coast around 8 am on 3rd May, triggering heavy rainfall coupled with high velocity winds with speed of 175 kmph in vast areas. Large areas in Puri and other places were submerged with water as heavy rains battered the entire coastal belt of the state. Cyclone Fani has triggered intense rainfall and winds in West Bengal destroying 50 houses in East Midnapore district. (Source: NDTV & Times Now News).

Due to the heavy influence of FANI, Parts of the Khulna and adjoining South-western part of Bangladesh started to inundated by evening of 03 May 2019. **A total 52 districts are projected as risks prone due to cyclonic wind or tidal surge.** Highest rainfall has been recorded at 65 mm at Rajarhat and 58 mm at Maymensingh yesterday evening (03 May (BMD)). Embankment in many parts of the country started collapsing from May 3. Disaster Forum’s Member organizations confirmed the collapse of Koyra (Khulna) embankment in Madinabad point, Paira river embankment at Meyendiabad point of Mirazagonj (Patuakhali) and bogi bandor point of shoronkhola (Bangerhat).

A Total 17 were killed and 30 people injured in different parts of the country since yesterday following cyclonic storm Fani.
